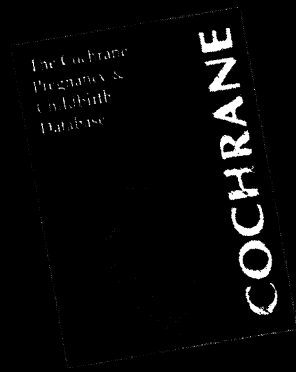

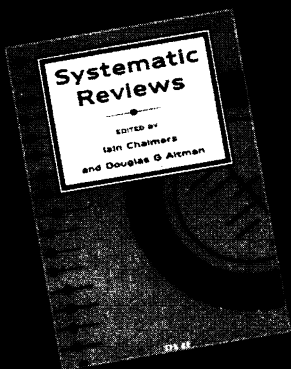

How do you choose a particular treatment or procedure?

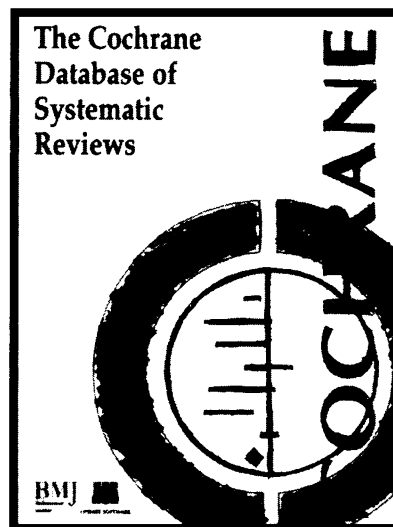
With over two million health research papers published each year it is impossible to keep up to date with the latest information, so it can be difficult to be sure that you are always making the best treatment choices.

Now the *Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews* aims to address this problem. Launched in April 1995, this electronic journal will give you information on the effects of health care, based on systematic reviews carried out by a growing international network of contributors to the Cochrane Collaboration.

The journal will be updated twice yearly, and with each issue existing reviews will be updated and new reviews will be added, so that eventually each area of health care will be covered.

Issue 2, published in November 1995, contains:

- 65 reviews dealing with the treatment of problems in pregnancy and childbirth, subfertility, stroke, schizophrenia, and parasitic diseases. PLUS protocols and titles for over 200 reviews currently in preparation on these and other subjects.
- A bibliography of previously published systematic reviews.
- A bibliography of methodological articles.
- Information on the Cochrane Collaboration.
